FOREIGN ECONOMIC POLICY MATERIAL AT THE LBJ LIBRARY PERTAINING TO **TRADE, BALANCE OF PAYMENTS, AND INTERNATIONAL MONETARY ISSUES** (Including the Kennedy Round and East-West Trade)

While this list includes the principal files available for research on international trade (including the Kennedy Round and East-West Trade), the balance of payments program, the gold crisis, and similar issues, the list is by no means exhaustive. Researchers may wish to consult the Johnson Library's finding aids to locate additional material. Some collections with important material on foreign economic policy, such as the Papers of Francis Bator and the Papers of Henry Fowler, have not yet been opened for research.

A list similar to this one is available on "Foreign Economic Policy Material at the Johnson Library Pertaining to Foreign Aid, Food for Peace, and Third World Economic Development (Asia, Africa, Latin America)."

Researchers on foreign economic policy may find useful the following works, which are based primarily on Johnson Library holdings: Foreign Economic Decisionmaking: Case Studies from the Johnson Administration and Their Implications, published in 1983 by the LBJ School of Public Affairs at the University of Texas at Austin; Sidney Weintraub, ed., Economic Coercion and U.S. Foreign Policy: Implications of Case Studies from the Johnson Administration (Boulder, Colorado, 1982); and Burton I. Kaufman, "Foreign Aid and the Balance of Payments Problems: The Vietnam War's Impact on Johnson's Foreign Economic Policy," in Robert A. Divine, ed., The Johnson Years - Volume II: Vietnam, the Environment, and Science, published in 1987 by the University Press of Kansas.

NATIONAL SECURITY FILE (NSF)

This file was the working file of President Johnson's special assistants for national security affairs, McGeorge Bundy and Walt W. Rostow. Documents in this file originated in the offices of Bundy and Rostow and their staffs, in the various executive departments and agencies, especially those having to do with foreign affairs and national defense, and in diplomatic and military posts around the world.

Access: About one-third of the National Security File has been processed and opened for research. Consult the finding aid in the reading room or borrow a copy by mail by writing to the Supervisory Archivist, LBJ Library, 2313 Red River St., Austin, Texas 78705. Those folders whose titles are preceded by an "X" or a date have been processed and their contents declassified in whole or in part. Lists of classified documents have been placed in those folders, and you may request mandatory declassification review of individual documents which have not yet been declassified in full.

NSF, National Security Council Histories

Prepared by the NSC staff in 1968, these histories are extremely useful collections of documents. There are four NSC histories dealing with trade, balance of payments, and currency issues. Since the histories were prepared by xeroxing documents in other parts of NSF and in other files, they provide access to documents the originals of which, in some cases, are in unprocessed files. All four histories include useful introductory material, such as chronologies and lists of documents. NSF, Country File.

Material on bilateral economic relations is scattered throughout the Country File's regular chronological volumes and the special files on head-of-state visits and correspondence. For example, the folder entitled "PM Wilson Briefing Book," 7/29/66, in the United Kingdom Country File (Box 216), includes briefing papers on US-UK economic relations. Consult the NSF finding aid to determine which folders in the Country File have been processed.

WHCF, NAME FILE

This file serves as a name index to the Subject File. Name Files typically contain copies of the first page (cross references) of documents that were filed in the Subject File. Files should be requested by names of individuals or organizations. A card file in the Reading Room indicates which Name Files have been opened. Name Files will be processed upon request.

WHCF CONFIDENTIAL FILE (C.F.)

Security classified and other sensitive material sent to the White House Central Files was usually placed in the Confidential File. The C.F. Subject File uses the same subject categories as WHCF. The Confidential File also includes a Name File (which serves as a name index to the C.F. Subject File), an agency reports file, and an oversize attachments file. C.F. is entirely processed, but portions are still classified.
